To the Honorable the Common Council: Gentlemen—The Department of Public Works to whom was referred the following petitions for paving respectfully report that the petitioners are the owners of the greater number of feet of real estate abutting the streets proposed to be improved. The Department, therefore, recommends that the prayers of the petitioners be granted and that the streets named with the limits stated be paved:

No. 1830—D. E. Gelmo, Blaine Avenue from La Salle to Linwood.

No. 3098—Mrs. Anna Philo, Horatio Street from Hammond to Military.

No. 1150—Mrs. L. Ziegler and 1542—Edwin C. Wisner, Euclid Avenue, Twelfth to 117 ft. E. of La Salle.

No. 2504—C. W. Kenzie, Greenway Avenue from Grand River to Southfield, and

No. 1689—John H. Wynn, Beniteau Avenue from Canfield to lots 2 and 3 Schepkes Sub.

It is estimated that the cost of these improvements will be as follows:

Blaine Avenue—From La Salle to Linwood, 26 feet wide, with sheet asphalt on 6-inch concrete foundation. Estimated cost Amherst curb, \$17,000; Medina curb, \$17,520.

Horatio Street—Hammond to Military, 26 feet wide, with sheet asphalt on 6-inch concrete foundation. Estimated cost, Amherst curb, \$6,890; Medina curb, \$7,100.

Euclid Avenue—Twelfth to 117 feet E. of La Salle, 26 feet wide, with sheet asphalt on 6-inch concrete foundation. Estimated cost, Amherst curb, \$31,980; Medina curb, \$32,970.

Greenway Avenue—Grand River to Southfield, 26 feet wide, with sheet asphalt on 6-inch concrete foundation. Estimated cost, Amherst curb, \$46,020; Medina curb, \$47,440.

Beniteau Avenue—Canfield to N'ly to N. L. lots 2 and 3 Schepke's Sub., 26 feet wide, with sheet asphalt on 6-inch concrete foundation. Estimated cost, Amherst curb, \$16,250; Medina curb, \$16,750.
