lic alley adjoining the westerly line of lot 67 of Section 7 of Governor and Judges Plan, as recorded in liber 34 page 544 of Deeds of Wayne County Records, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the easterly line of the public alley 2.17 feet distant, on course north 30 degrees 49 minutes, 1 second west from the intersection of said easterly line of the public alley with the northerly line of John R Street, thence north 30 degrees 49 minutes 1 second west 125.91 feet to a point; thence north 59 degrees 10 minutes 59 seconds east 1.95 feet to a point; thence south 29 degrees 56 minutes 15 seconds east 125.89 feet to the place of beginning." (Containing 122.76 square feet of land);
