are the correct ones which each individual or set of individuals should be assessed at and pay, and that the said assessments be collected from the several persons liable to pay the same according to law.

Gentlemen-I desire to inform your Honorable Body that, in accordance with your request that the Board of Education provide a 50 ft. outlet at the Washington School site, Dequindre and Lawley avenues, instead of 30 ft. as authorized by the Board at its meeting of November 13, 1924, the Board of Education, at a meeting held February 12th last, rescinded its former action and authorized that the Board deed to the City of Detroit, street purposes, 50 ft. along for east side of the Washington School site, to provide for the closing and vacating of Cody Avenue.

Provided, That by reason of the vacation of the above described street and alleys, the City of Detroit does not waive any rights in the lateral sewer located in street or alleys aforesaid, and shall at all times have the right to enter upon the premises if found necessary on account of the sewer located therein to repair same, and provided further, that petitioner shall not build over the above described street and alleys without first securing the approval of the City Engineer and the Board of Health,

Resolved, That the City Controller be and is hereby directed to execute quit-claim deeds covering the property herein vacated. Adopted as follows:
