

From the Board of Assessors.

March 9, 1926.

To the Honorable the Common Council:

Gentlemen—We herewith transmit to your honorable body, Street Opening Assessment Roll number 524 for defraying a part of the expense and cost of taking private property for the opening and extending of Cheyenne Avenue, from alley north of Grand River Avenue to Schoolcraft Avenue.

This roll has been prepared pursuant to and in accordance with the resolution adopted by your honorable body on February 16, 1926.

The benefits of the whole property included in the taxing district equals the sums assessed thereon, and the lands included in the said assessment district were assessed in proportion to the benefits specially derived by them from such improvement. The notice required by law has been given to the parties in interest, as will appear by the annexed notice and affidavit of publication. We have therefore signed the same and report it to your honorable body, and herewith present the following resolution to that end.

Resolved, That the Common Council of the City of Detroit do hereby approve and confirm Street Opening Assessment Roll number 524 for defraying part of the expense and cost of taking private property for the opening and extending of Cheyenne Avenue from alley north of Grand River Avenue to Schoolcraft Avenue.

Which said roll has been prepared pursuant to and in accordance with the resolution adopted by the Common Council February 16, 1926; further resolved, that the description of the premises and the names of persons contained therein are received as correct; that the lots and parcels of land contained therein and the several owners and occupants have been assessed in said roll in proportion to the benefits specially derived by them, and each of them, from the opening and extending of said Cheyenne Avenue; that the benefits of such improvement to such lots and parcels of land, and the several owners thereof, equals the assessment levied against the property contained in said assessment roll; that the benefits to the whole of the property included in the taxing district equals the sum assessed thereon, and that

the sums set forth in the said assessment roll are the correct ones which each lot or parcel of land should be assessed and pay, and that the said assessment upon such lot or parcel of land, be collected from the several persons liable to pay the same according to law, and shall become due and payable within 60 days from the date of the first publication by the City Treasurer of the notice of said assessment.
