Resolved, That "all that part of public alley, 20 ft. wide, and all that part of Kay street, as opened, lying north of and adjoining the northerly line of lot 395 of Nardin Park Subdivision on the northwest fractional $\frac{1}{4}$ of Fractional Section 34 and the S. W. part of $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30 and west part of $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31 of the 10,000 Acre Tract as recorded in Liber 26, page 96 of Plats of Wayne County Records described as follows: Beginning at a point on the northerly line of said lot 395, said point being distant on a course N. 86 deg. 34 min. west 3.77 ft. from the northeasterly corner of said lot 395, thence along the northerly line of said lot N. 86 deg. 34 min. west 72.76 ft. to a point; thence along a line N. 63 deg. 26 min. east 61.49 ft. to a point; thence along a line S. 27 deg. 58 min. east 36.00 ft. to the place of beginning," be and the same is hereby vacated to become a part and parcel of the adjoining property,

Provided, Petitioner pays into the City Treasury within 60 days from the date of the adoption of this resolution the sum of \$300.00, and further

Provided, Petitioner deeds to the City of Detroit for alley purposes "all that part of lot 395 of last men-

tioned subdivision, described as follows: Beginning at the northeasterly corner of said lot; thence along the northerly line of said lot N. 86 deg. 34 min. west 3.77 ft. to a point; thence along a line S. 27 deg. 58 min. east 3.95 ft. to a point on the southeasterly line of said lot 395; thence along said line N. 30 deg. 01 min. east 3.77 ft. to the place of beginning," and further

Provided, Petitioner bears the entire expense of relocating or rerouting any public utilities now installed in said alley which it may be necessary to remove due to the closing of same, and further

Resolved, That the City Controller be and he is hereby directed to execute quit-claim deed covering the property herein vacated.
