Resolved, That "all that part of Voight street 50 feet wide, adjoining the northerly line of lot 56 and the southerly line of lot 57 of Grosse Pointe Villas Subdivision of the westerly part of P. C. 111, north of Mack avenue as recorded in Liber 36, page 56 of Plats of Wayne County Records," be and the same is hereby vacated to become a part and parcel of the adjoining property.

Provided, Petitioner reimburses the owners to the extent of the value of any utilities now installed in said street which it may be necessary to abandon, due to the closing of same, or bears the entire expense of relocating or rerouting any public utilities now installed in said street, which it may be necessary to relocate or reroute due to the closing of same, and further

Provided, Petitioner agrees to pay into the City Treasury whatever expense may have been incurred by the City in the matter of paving, curbing, crosswalks, sidewalks, etc., with-in the lines of street herein vacated as may be certified by the City Engineer, and further

Provided, That by reason of the vacation of the above described street the City of Detroit does not waive any rights in the lateral sewer located in street aforesaid and shall at all times have the right to enter upon the premises if found necessary on account of said sewer to repair same, and provided further that petitioner shall not build over the above described street without first securing the approval of the City Engineer and

the Board of Health, and further Resolved, That the City Controller be and is hereby directed to execute quit claim deed covering the property herein vacated.
