Resolved, That "all of the public alley, 20 ft. wide, adjoining the southerly lines of lots 11 and 12 of a Town Plat of the Farm of Antoine Dequindre as recorded in Liber 10, pages 715, 716 and 717 of City Records," be and the same is hereby vacated to become a part and parcel of the said adjoining property.

Provided, that petitioner files with the City Clerk within 30 days from the date of the adoption of this resolution an agreement in writing waiving all damages which may accrue to lots 9, 10, 11 and 12 of last mentioned subdivision, and alley herein vacated by reason of grade separation, and further

Provided, Petitioner reimburses the owners to the extent of the value of any utilities now installed in said alleys which it may be necessary to abandon, due to the closing of same, or bears the entire expense of relocating or rerouting any public utilities now installed in said alleys, which it may be necessary to relocate or reroute due to the closing of same, and further

Provided, that by reason of the vacation of the above described alleys the City of Detroit does not waive any right in the lateral sewers located in alleys aforesaid and shall at

all times have the right to enter upon the premises if found necessary on account of said sewer to repair same and provided further that petitioner shall not build over the above described alleys without first securing the approval of the City Engineer and the Board of Health, and further

Resolved, That the City Controller be and is hereby directed to execute quit claim deed covering the property herein vacated.
