Vacation of Alley

To the Honorable, the Common Council:

Gentlemen—To your Committee of the Whole was referred petition of the ~~Proger~~ Grocer Grocery & Baking Co. (985), for the vacation of a portion of the east and west alley in the block east of Junction avenue between McGregor and Merritt avenues. Your committee finds that the alley now comes to a dead-end, and that petitioner is the owner of all property abutting upon the portion to be vacated. After consultation with the City Plan Commission, and careful consideration of the request, your committee recommends that same be granted, provided petitioner deeds to the city the land needed for the widening of Merritt avenue, south of Outlot 43. We therefore offer the following resolution.

Resolved, That "all of the public alley, 20 ft. wide, adjoining the southerly line of lots 1, 2 and 3 and adjoining the northerly line of lots 33, 34 and 35 of McMillan's Subdivision of the south 270 ft. of the east half of the rear concession of P. C. 260, lying north of the north line of Annexation street, as recorded in Liber 12, page 95, of Plats of Wayne County Records," be and the same is hereby vacated to become a part and parcel of the adjoining property.

Provided, Petitioner deeds to the City of Detroit for street purposes

"the southerly part of O. L. 43 of the Plat of P. C. 30 and back concession thereof as laid out by the Commissioners for dividing the estate of the late General John R. Williams of the ceased, as recorded in Liber 1, page 67 of Plats of Wayne County Records, described as follows: beginning at the southeasterly corner of lot 35 of the Millan's Subdivision heretofore mentioned; thence along a line N. 61 deg. 26 min. E. 251.80 ft. to the southwest-erly corner of lot 1 of Joseph Hall's Subdivision of part of Outlot 43, P. C. 30, as recorded in Liber 21, page 42 of Plats of Wayne County Records; thence along the westerly line extended southerly of said lot 1 S. 28 deg. 04 min. E. 20.04 ft. to a point on the southerly line of O. L. 43 of the Plat of P. C. 30 heretofore mentioned; thence along said line S. 61 deg. 26 min. W. 251.80 ft. to a point on the dividing line between P. C.'s 30 and 260; thence along said line N. 28 deg. 04 min. W. 20.04 ft. to the place of beginning," and further

Provided, Petitioner bears the entire expense of relocating or rerouting any public utilities now installed in said alley which it may be necessary to remove due to the closing of same; and further

Provided, That by reason of the vacation of the above described alley the City of Detroit does not waive any rights in the lateral sewer located in the alley aforesaid and shall at all times have the right to enter upon the premises if found necessary on account of said sewer to repair same, and provided further that petitioner shall not build over the above described alley without first securing the approval of the City Engineer and the Board of Health; and further

Resolved, That the City Controller be and is hereby directed to execute quit claim deed covering the property herein vacated.
