Resolved, that "all of public alley, 18 feet wide, lying in the rear of lots 2272 to 2282, both inclusive, and lots 2357 to 2367, both inclusive, of Park Drive Subdivision No. 7 of part of Private Claim 231, as recorded in Liber 60 Page 28 of Plats of Wayne County Records," be and the same is hereby vacated to become part and parcel of the adjoining property.

Provided, That by reason of the vacation of the above described alley, the City of Detroit does not waive any rights in the lateral sewers located in alley aforesaid, and shall, at all times, have the right to enter upon the premises if found necessary on account of said sewer to repair same, and provided further that petitioner shall not build over the above described alley without first securing the permission of the City Engineer and the Board of Health, and further

Provided, Petitioner reimburses the owners to the extent of the value of any utilities now installed in said alley which it may be necessary to abandon, due to the closing of same, or bears the entire expense of relocating or rerouting any public utilities now installed in said alley, which it may be necessary to relocate or reroute due to the closing of same, and further

Resolved, That the City Controller be and is hereby directed to execute quit claim deed covering the property herein vacated.
