Vacation of Alley

To the Honorable, the Common Council:

Gentlemen—To your Committee of the Whole was referred petition of George W. Rudell (11622), requesting the vacation of a portion of the east and west alley north of Fort street between Wheelock and Solvay avenues, petitioner offering to deed a new 20-ft. outlet into Wheelock avenue. After consultation with the City Plan Commission, and careful consideration of the request, your committee recommends that same be granted, provided petitioner also deeds additional 6 ft. of land to widen the north and south alley to permit an easier turn from the 10-ft. alley, and we therefore offer the following resolution.

Resolved, That "All of public alley 10.0 feet wide, adjoining the southerly line of the easterly 126.50 feet of lot 154 of Moses W. Fields Subdivision of part of Private Claim 67 as recorded in Liber 7, page 62 of the Plats of Wayne County Records be and the same is hereby vacated to become a part and parcel of the adjoining property.

Provided, Petitioner deed for alley purposes, "the northerly 20 feet of lot 153, the westerly 6 feet of the southerly 20 feet of lot 153 and the westerly 6 feet of lot 154 of said Moses W. Fields Subdivision, and further

Provided, That by reason of the vacation of the above described alley the City of Detroit does not waive any right in the lateral sewers located in alley aforesaid and shall at all times have the right to enter upon the premises if found necessary on account of said sewer to repair same, and provided further that petitioner shall not build over the above described alley without first securing the approval of the City Engineer and the Board of Health, and further

Provided, That if at any time the alley described as the northerly 20 feet of lot 153 is ordered graded and paved, the entire expense of such grading and paving is borne by the Petitioner, and further

Provided, That petitioner reimburse the owners to the extent of the value of any utilities now installed in said alley, which it may be necessary to

abandon, due to the closing of same, or bears the entire expense of relocating or rerouting any public utilities now installed in said alley, which it may be necessary to relocate or reroute due to the closing of same, and further

Resolved, That the City Controller be and is hereby directed to execute quit claim deed covering the property herein vacated.

By Councilman Callahan:

Resolved, That the Department of Public Works be and is hereby authorized and directed to issue permits as follows:

Peoples Wayne County Bank (12578) for the construction of an areaway on Mansfield avenue at side of their building on the northeast corner of Plymouth road, same to be 5 feet long over all and to extend out 4 feet 6 inches from building.

Union League Building Corp. (12580) for the construction of an areaway on the north side of Fort street west to extend out 9 feet 4 inches from building line and to be 83 feet long; and another areaway on the west side of Wayne street to extend out not more than 7 feet 4 inches from the building and to be 130 feet long, both to be covered with solid slab and prism lights and to have no openings.

Provided, That said work shall be performed under the supervision of the Department of Public Works, and in accordance with the plans submitted to and approved by said department.

Provided, That no rights in the public streets, alleys or other public places shall be considered waived by
