Vacation of Strip of Land

To the Honorable, the Common Council:

Gentlemen—To your Committee of the Whole was referred petition of Arnold Ternes (1796), requesting the vacation of a portion of Eight Mile road between Kelly road and Cushing ave. adjoining Ternes Superhighway Subdivision. Your committee is ad-

vised by the City Plan Commission that at the time this subdivision was platted the owners deeded to the city 102 ft. for half of the Eight Mile road at a width of 204 ft., but that subsequent to that time this road was widened to its full width of 204 ft. without utilizing all of the land dedicated by the foregoing subdivision, and that at the present time there is a surplus strip of property on the south side of Eight Mile road which should be vacated to the owners of the abutting property.
