By Councilman Van Antwerp:
Resolved, That the public alley, 13 feet in width, lying in the block bounded by Oak Drive, Birchcrest Drive, Margareta Avenue and Clarita Avenue and lying in the rear of Lots 25 to 34 both inclusive and Lots 63 to 72 both inclusive of Palmer Park Gardens Subdivision of the Northwest ¼ of the Northwest ¼ of Section 10, T. 1. S. R. 12 East as recorded in Liber 30 Page 52 of Plats of Wayne County Records", be and the same is hereby vacated as a public alley and converted into a public easement, which shall be subjected to the following agreements, covenants, uses, reservations and regulations which shall be observed by the owners of said Lots 25 to 34 inclusive and Lots 63 to 72 inclusive of Palmer Park Gardens Subdivision heretofore mentioned and by their grantees and assigns and their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, to wit:

First, said owners hereby grant to and for the use of the public an easement or right-of-way over said vacated alley herein described for the purpose of installing, maintaining, repairing, removing or replacing any sewer, conduit, telephone, telegraph, electric light or other poles or things usually placed or installed in a public alley, in the City of Detroit, with the right of ingress and egress at any time to and over said vacated alley for the purposes above set forth.

Second, said owners for their heirs and assigns further agree that no buildings or structures of any kind whatsoever (except the necessary line fences dividing said lots) shall be built or placed upon said 18 foot easement or any part thereof, so that said easement shall be forever of easy access for the above named purposes.

Third, that said easement shall be used for the same purposes for which public alleys are generally used in the City of Detroit, excepting that same shall not be opened for the passage of vehicles therein.

Provided, Petitioners deposit into the 3-B General Road Fund the sum of \$16.21 for each of the 20 lots in the block involved herein or a total of \$324.21 to cover the expense that has been incurred by the City in the matters of paving and curbing within the lines of the alley vacated hereby and to cover the expense of removing the paving return leading into the alley vacated hereby and to construct a sidewalk in front of same.

Resolved, That the City Controller be and he is hereby directed to execute a quit claim deed to each of several owners of the lots included in said block of land hereinbefore described and excepting therefrom the exceptions and reservations hereinafore mentioned.
