Gentlemen—To your Committee of the Whole was referred petition of the Fisher Body Corporation (6925), for the vacation of a portion of the north and south and east and west alley in the block south of Fort street and east of Crawford avenue. Resolved, That "the public alley 10 feet wide lying first easterly of and parallel to Crawford Avenue and south of Fort Street and being more particularly described as: All the public alley 10 feet wide and lying in

rear of and adjoining Lots 9 to 19, both inclusive, and the north 20 feet of Lot 20 of "Kurth's Subdivision of Lot No. 61 of Crawfords Subdivision of Fort Tract being part of P. C. No. 268 lying along the east side of Crawford Avenue and between Fort Street and the W. St. L. & P. R. R. as recorded in Liber 10, Page 5 of Plats of Wayne County Records. Also the public alley 20 feet wide being the north-erly 20 feet of Lot 20 above mentioned Subdivision" be and the same are hereby vacated to become part and parcel of the adjoining property.

Provided, That petitioner shall deed to the City of Detroit for alley purposes "the southerly 20 feet of Lot 8 of the above mentioned Subdivision," and further

Provided, That by reason of the vacation of the above described alleys, the City of Detroit does not waive any rights in the lateral sewers located therein and shall at all times have the right to enter upon the premises if found necessary on account of said sewers to repair same, and provided that petitioner, his heirs and assigns shall not build over the above described alleys without first securing the approval of the City Engineer and the Board of Health, and further

Provided, That petitioner reimburse the owners to the extent of the value of any utilities now installed in said alleys which it may be necessary to abandon due to the closing of same, or bears the entire expense of same, relocating or rerouting any public utilities now installed in said alleys which it may be necessary to relocate or reroute due to the closing of same and further

Provided, That if at any time in the future the alley described as "the southerly 20 feet of Lot 8, Kurth's Subdivision" is ordered graded and paved the entire expense of such grading and paving shall be borne by petitioner, his heirs or assigns, and further

Resolved, That the City Controller be and he is hereby directed to execute a Quit Claim deed covering the property herein vacated.
