

out first securing the approval of the City Engineer, Department of Buildings and Safety Engineering and Board of Health, and wherever column footings adjacent to the sewer extend below the bottom of the pipe, a solid concrete foundation shall be built extending from the centerline of the sewer to the bottom of the footing for the full length of the footing, and further

Provided, That petitioner reimburses the owners to the extent of the value of any utilities now installed in said alley which it may be necessary to abandon due to the closing of said alley, or bears the entire expense of relocating or rerouting any public utilities now installed in said alley which it may be necessary to relocate or reroute due to the closing of same, and further

Resolved, That the City Controller be and he is hereby directed to execute quit-claim deed covering the property herein vacated.

Vacation of Alleys

To the Honorable, the Common Council:

Gentlemen—To your Committee of the Whole was referred petition of the Stroh Brewery Co. (2361), requesting the vacation of alleys in the block north of Elizabeth St., east of Hastings St. and south of Columbia St. Your committee is advised by the City Plan Commission that petitioner is the owner of all property in the block abutting upon the alleys to be closed, and no other property owners would be affected by the vacation of the alleys. After careful consideration of the request, your committee recommends that same be granted, and offers the following resolution.

By Councilman Bradley:

Resolved, That "all that part of public alleys lying east of Hastings Street between Elizabeth and Columbia Streets more particularly described as all of public alley 15 feet wide adjoining the easterly line of Lots 1 to 4 both inclusive of Subdivision of Lots 48, 49, 50 and 51 of Crane and Wesson Section of the Louis Moran Farm as recorded in Liber 1 Page 123 of Plats of Wayne County Records and the westerly line of Lot 47 of Plat of Crane and Wesson Section of the Louis Moran Farm as recorded

in Liber 1 Page 58 of Plats of Wayne County Records."

Also "all of public alley 20 feet wide as of Plat of alley through Lot 6 Subdivision of Out Lot 181 Rivard Farm as recorded in Liber 1 Page 205 of Plats of Wayne County Records."

Also "all of public alley, 20 feet wide, adjoining the northerly line of Lots 28 to 39 both inclusive and the southerly line of Lots 40 to 47 both inclusive of Plat of Crane and Wesson Section heretofore mentioned."

Also "that portion of public alley, in rear of Lot 40 of Plat of Crane and Wesson Section heretofore mentioned, deeded to the City of Detroit and accepted by Common Council September 18, 1907."

Be and the same are hereby vacated to become a part and parcel of the adjoining property.

Provided, That by reason of the vacation of the above described alleys the City of Detroit does not waive any right in the lateral sewers located therein, and shall at all times have the right to enter upon the premises if found necessary on account of said sewers to repair same, and provided further, that petitioner shall not build over the above described alleys without first securing the approval of the City Engineer and the Board of Health, and further

Provided, That petitioner reimburses the owners to the extent of the value of any utilities now installed in said alleys which it may be necessary to abandon due to the closing of same, or bears the entire expense of relocating or rerouting any public utilities now installed in said alleys which it may be necessary to relocate or reroute due to the closing of same, and further

Resolved, That the City Controller be and is hereby directed to execute quit claim deed covering the property herein vacated.
