WHEREAS, E. Zimmer has petitioned the Common Council requesting that the City sell to him a strip of land described as the Easterly seven (7) feet of Lot 28 of Barlum and Willette's Subdivision; and WHEREAS, it appears that petitioner paid special assessments levied upon Lot 29 for paving and sidewalk, in the sum of approximately \$800.00 which assessments, under the decisions of the Supreme Court of this State are invalid by reason of an intervening parcel of property existing between the established street

line and the adjoining property; and WHEREAS, the petitioner is entitled to a refund of said assessments and has agreed to waive his right to the said refund in consideration of the City deeding to him the said seven (7) foot strip of land; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Assessors has placed a valuation on said strip of land in the sum of \$180.00, now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Controller be and he hereby is authorized to execute a quit-claim deed to the said seven (7) foot strip of land to petitioner and to deliver the same to him upon receipt of a waiver and release of any claim of petitioner for a refund by reason of said invalid special assessment for paving and sidewalk, said release to be approved by the Corporation Counsel.
