By Councilman Bradley:

Resolved, That "all of public alley, 18 feet wide adjoining the westerly line of Lots 83 to 94, both inclusive of Jeremiah Trombly's Gratiot Lawn Subdivision of part of Lot 3 and part of Lot 4 of Trombly's Subdivision of part of Fractional Section 11, T. 1 S., R. 12 East as recorded in Liber 55, Page 42 of Plats of Wayne County Records, being that part of north and south alley lying between Rowe and Annott Avenues and between the northerly line of 20 foot public alley lying first northerly of Six Mile Road and the southerly line extended west-

erly of lot 95 of said Trombly's Gratiot Lawn Subdivision," be and the same is hereby vacated to become a part and parcel of the adjoining property.

Provided, Petitioner deeds to the City of Detroit for alley purposes, "the easterly 22.00 feet of the southerly 35.27 feet of lot 52 and the northerly 4.73 feet of the easterly 22.00 feet of lot 53 of Jeremiah Trombly's Gratiot Lawn Subdivision heretofore mentioned," and further

Provided, Petitioner reimburses the owners to the extent of the value of any utilities now installed in said alley which it may be necessary to abandon due to the closing of same, or bears the entire expense of relocating or rerouting any public utilities now installed in said alley which it may be necessary to relocate or reroute due to the closing of same, and further

Provided, That if at any time in the future, the alley described as "the easterly 22.00 feet of the southerly 35.27 feet of lot 52 and the northerly 4.73 feet of the easterly 22.00 feet of lot 53 of Jeremiah Trombly's Gratiot Lawn Subdivision" is ordered graded and paved, the entire expense of such grading and paving is borne by petitioner, and further

Provided, That by reason of the vacation of the above described alley, the City of Detroit does not waive any rights in the lateral sewers located in alley aforesaid, and shall at all times have the right to enter upon premises if found necessary on account of said sewers, to repair same, and provided further, that petitioner shall not build over the above described alley without first securing the approval of the City Engineer and the Board of Health, and further

Resolved, That the City Controller be and he is hereby directed to execute Quit Claim deed covering the property herein vacated.
