To the Honorable, the Common Council:

Gentlemen—To your Committee of the Whole was referred petition of Fred Brown (787), requesting permission to use ten feet of McNichols Road between Prairie and San Juan aves. for building purposes, due to the fact that the lots in the adjacent subdivision extend ten feet nearer to the center of the street than petitioner's property. Your committee is advised by the City Plan Commission that when the subdivision, in which petitioner's property is located, was platted 43 ft. was dedicated for McNichols Road (Six Mile Road), but that adjacent subdivisions dedicated only 33 ft. for the street, thus placing petitioner's front property line ten feet further back than adjoining buildings. After hearing with petitioner, consultation with the Corporation Counsel, and careful consideration of the matter, your committee recommends that the request be granted in accordance with the following resolution.

Resolved, That all that part of McNichols Road West, the same being the northerly 10 feet lying south of and adjoining Lots 1 to 4 both inclusive of Staffords Inter-College Subdivision of part of Lot J of J. M. Dwyer's acres being Subdivision of the south $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ and the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, T. 1 S., R. 11 E., City of Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan, as recorded in Liber 46 of Plats, page 82, Wayne County Records, be and the same is hereby vacated to become a part and parcel of Lots 1 to 4 both inclusive of the aforementioned subdivision;

Provided, That in the event of the City of Detroit decides at any future time to use the property herein described for street purposes, then the same shall revert to the City upon the adoption by the Common Council of a resolution declaring its intention to so use the property;

Provided, further, that such resolution shall become effective immediately upon the adoption of said resolution and without cost to the City either for the land herein described or any improvements hereafter constructed upon this property;

Provided, further, that the vendee, his representatives, heirs or assigns will remove any such improvements and restore the property to its original condition without expense to the City; and

Provided, further, that the terms of this resolution shall be incorporated in and be a part of the deed herein authorized to be executed by the controller and the same shall be filed with the Register of Deeds, Wayne County, Michigan.
