

Vacation of Alley

To the Honorable, the Common Council:

Gentlemen—To your Committee of the Whole was referred petition of David D. Dunlop, et al. (1764), requesting that the 9-ft. alley lying easterly of Woodmont Road between Davison Ave. and the alley first south of Schoolcraft Ave. be converted into an easement for public utilities only, or that in the event this cannot be done, that the abutting owners be permitted to maintain temporary obstructions, other than buildings, within the limits of the alley. After consultation with the City Plan Commission, and careful consideration of the matter, your committee recommends that petitioners be permitted to maintain temporary obstructions, and offers the following resolution.

Resolved, That the public alleys 18 feet in width lying in blocks bounded by Monte Vista, Pinehurst, Seven Mile and Cambridge Avenues, and Pinehurst, Mendota, Seven Mile and Cam-

bridge Avenues more particularly described as the easterly 9 feet of north and south public alley 18 feet wide lying west of and adjoining the westerly line of Lots 19, 27, 48, 50, 56 and 57 of College Woods, being a Subdivision of part of the S. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. R. 11 E., Greenfield Twp., Wayne Co., Michigan as recorded in Liber 50 Page 33 of Plats of Wayne County Records.

Also the westerly 9 feet of north and south public alley, 18 feet wide lying east of and adjoining the easterly line of Lots 37, 43, 46, 66, 67, 68 and lots 70 to 76 both inclusive of last mentioned Subdivision.

Also the easterly 9 feet of north and south public alley, 18 feet wide lying west of and adjoining the westerly line of Lot 17 of last mentioned Subdivision.

Also the easterly 9 feet of north and south public alley, 18 feet wide lying west of and adjoining the westerly line of Lot 18 of last mentioned Subdivision.

Also the easterly 9 ft. of north and south public alley, 18 feet wide lying west of any adjoining the westerly line of Lot 20 of last mentioned Subdivision.

Also the easterly 9 feet of north and south public alley, 18 feet wide lying west of and adjoining the westerly line of Lot 21 of last mentioned Subdivision.

Also the easterly 9 feet of north and south public alley, 18 feet wide lying west of and adjoining the westerly line of Lot 22 of last mentioned Subdivision.

Also the easterly 9 feet of north and south public alley, 18 feet wide lying west of and adjoining the westerly line of Lot 23 of last mentioned Subdivision.

Also the easterly 9 feet of north and south public alley, 18 feet wide lying west of and adjoining the westerly line of Lots 24 and 25 of last mentioned Subdivision.

Also the easterly 9 feet of north and south public alley, 18 feet wide lying west of and adjoining the westerly line of Lot 26 of last mentioned Subdivision.

Also the westerly 9 feet of north and south public alley, 18 feet wide lying east of and adjoining the easterly line of Lot 36 of last mentioned Subdivision.

Also the westerly 9 feet of north and south public alley, 18 feet wide lying east of and adjoining the easterly line of Lot 38 of last mentioned Subdivision.

Also the westerly 9 feet of north and south public alley, 18 feet wide lying east of and adjoining the easterly line of Lot 39 of last mentioned Subdivision.
