By Councilman Sweeney:

Resolved, That all of Allonby Avenue between Memorial and Asbury Park Avenues more particularly described as a strip of land 60 feet wide lying north of and adjoining the northerly line of Frischkorn's Grand-Dale Subdivision No. 3, being part of the S.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Sec. 25, T. 1 S. R. 10 E., Redford Twp., Wayne Co., Mich., as recorded in Liber 52, Page 3 of Plats of Wayne County Records and being the same property deeded to the City of Detroit for street purposes by deed recorded March 21, 1927 in Liber 2571, Page 77 of Deeds of Wayne County Records.

Be and the same is hereby vacated to become a part and parcel of land in the S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 25, T. 1 S. R. 10 E. described as Beginning at the intersection of the N. & S.  $\frac{1}{4}$  line of Sec. 25 and the S. line of the Pere Marquette Railroad, said point being distant S. 0 degrees 37 minutes 20 seconds West 49.50 feet from the center line of said Railroad which is also the E. & W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  line of Section 25; thence along said N. & S.  $\frac{1}{4}$  line S. 0 degrees 37 minutes 20 seconds West 647.15 feet to the N. line of Frischkorn's Grand-Dale Sub'n. No. 3; thence along said line North 89 degrees 10 minutes 30 seconds West 1309.37 feet to the east line of Frischkorn's Grand View Subn.; thence along said line, North 0 degrees 31 minutes 30 seconds East 650.40 feet to the south line of the Pere Marquette Railroad; thence along said line South 89 degrees 02 minutes East 1310.49 feet to the place of beginning.

The City Controller be and is hereby directed to issue a Quit Claim Deed to The Frischkorn Development Company, a Delaware Corporation as owner in fee of adjoining property.

**Vacation of Clarita and Manor Aves.  
and Alleys**

Gentlemen—To your Committee of the Whole was referred petition of the Grace Hospital (8748), for the vacation of Clarita ave. from Meyers Road to Montevista ave.; Manor ave. from Clarita ave. to a point 140 ft. north of Clarita ave., also portions of the north and south alleys north of Clarita ave. between Meyers road and Montevista aves., petitioner offering to dedicate 60 ft. of land for the purpose of relocating Clarita ave. northerly of the present street. After consultation with the City Plan Commission, and careful consideration of the matter, your committee recommends that the petition be granted, and offers the following resolution.

Resolved, That all of Clarita Avenue, all that part of Manor Avenue and public alleys lying between Meyers Road, Monte Vista Avenue, Clarita Avenue and Seven Mile Road more particularly described as all of Clarita Avenue. 60 feet wide as now established being the Clarita Avenue, 50 feet wide as platted in Marygrove Manor, a Subdivision of part of the W.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 8, T. 1, S. R. 11 E., City of Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan, as recorded in Liber 61 Page 67 of Plats of Wayne County Records and that portion of the N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8, Greenfield Twp., dedicated for widening and opening of said Clarita Avenue and accepted by the Common Council on July 5th, 1938, J. C. C. Page 1618.

Also all that part of Clarita Avenue, 60 feet wide as now established being a portion of the N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8, T. 1, S. R. 11 E., lying west of and adjoining Monte Vista Avenue being that portion dedicated for opening of said street and accepted
