Resolved, that all of north and south alley lying between Barron, Dearborn avenues and P. M. R. R. of W., being a part of lot 7 of Barron's Subdivision of part of lot 2 of plat of part of P. C. 340, City of Detroit, Wayne Co., Michigan as recorded in Liber 37, Page 72 of Plats of Wayne County Records and being that portion of public alley deeded to the City of Detroit by deed dated August 18, 1914 and recorded September 16, 1930 in Liber 3454, Page 387 of Deeds of Wayne County Records, described as all that part of Lot 2 of Estate of Joseph Barron, deceased, in P. C.
