Resolved, That the Department of Public Works be and it is hereby authorized and directed to issue permits to the following firms to maintain spur tracks at the locations mentioned, as per blue prints submitted: Macon-Kalin Coal & Coke Company (2377), across Charest St., between McDougall and Gallagher, and alley east and west of Charest, connected with, and to be maintained on the east side of the Detroit Terminal Railroad.

Allen Industries, Inc. (2378), formerly in the name of Detroit Screw Works, in Guoin Street, west of Riopelle, connected with, and to be maintained on the south side of the Grand Trunk Railway.

Provided, That said spur tracks are maintained in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Compiled Ordinances of the City of Detroit for the year 1936, as amended, and under the supervision and inspection of the Department of Public Works, and further

Provided, that this resolution is revocable at the will, whim or caprice of the Common Council, and grantees hereby expressly waive any right to claim damages or compensation for property constructed and/or maintained hereunder, or for the removal of same, and further that grantees acquire no implied or other privileges hereunder, not expressly stated herein:

Resolved, That all that part of north and south public alley in block bounded by Cardoni, Russell, Lantz and State Fair Avenues, more particularly described as that part of north and south public alley 15 feet

wide lying between the easterly line of Lots 238, 239, 240, the easterly line of the southerly 12 feet of Lot 241 and the westerly line of the southerly 12 feet of Lot 290, the westerly line of Lots 291, 292, 293, all of Washington Boulevard Subdn. of W. $\frac{1}{2}$ of W. $\frac{1}{2}$ of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, T. 1 S., R. 11 E., Greenfield Twp., Wayne Co., Michigan, as recorded in Liber 34, Page 8 of Plats of Wayne County Records be and the same is hereby vacated to become part and parcel of the adjoining property.

Provided, Owners in fee deed to the City of Detroit, the northerly 20 feet of Lots 241 and 290 of Washington Boulevard Sub'n. of W. $\frac{1}{2}$ of W. $\frac{1}{2}$ of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, T. 1 S., R. 11 E., Greenfield Twp., Wayne Co., Michigan as recorded in Liber 34, Page 8 of Plats of Wayne County Records. To be used for alley purposes and further

Provided, Petitioners deposit with the City Treasurer the sum of \$330.00 being the estimated cost of removing and re-routing over-head P.L.C. wires in above described alley as per estimate No. 314, said sum to be credited to P.L.C. Account No. 9, and further

Provided, Petitioners deposit with the Permit Division of the Department of Public Works the sum of \$200.00 being the estimated cost of constructing a new manhole at the intersection of the east and west alley herein dedicated with the north and south alley. Should the actual cost of construction of such manhole including inspection and supervision be less than the \$200.00 deposit, the balance is to be refunded to petitioner, and further

Provided, Petitioners deposit with the Permit Division of the Department of Public Works the sum of \$200.62, said amount being the estimated cost of constructing new returns at Cardoni and Russell Streets at intersections of alleys herein dedicated, and further

Provided, Petitioners reimburse the owners to the extent of the value of any utilities now installed in said alley which it may be necessary to abandon due to the closing of said alley or bear the entire expense of relocating or rerouting any public utilities now installed in said alley which it may be necessary to relocate or reroute due to the closing of said alley, and further

Resolved, that upon compliance with the above provisos, the City Controller be and is hereby directed to issue quit claim deed to Truth Evangelical Lutheran Church, a Michigan corporation as owners in fee of adjoining property.
