To be used for alley purposes, and further

Provided, Petitioners deposit with the Permit Division of the Department of Public Works the sum of \$240.50, said sum being the estimated cost of removing existing return at alley herein vacated and the estimated cost of new return to be constructed at alley herein dedicated, and further

Provided, Owners in fee file with the City Clerk within thirty days an agreement in writing, waiving any claims for damages which may arise due to the separation of grades affecting all of property herein vacated, and further

Provided, Petitioners reimburse the owners to the extent of the value of any utilities now installed in said alley which it may be necessary to abandon due to the closing of same or bear the entire expense of relocating or rerouting any public utilities in said alleys which it may be necessary to relocate or reroute due to the closing of same, and further

Provided, all taxes are paid on property herein affected, and further

Resolved that upon compliance with the above provisos the City Controller be and is hereby directed to issue Quit Claim Deeds to George C. Cnudde, Arthur Cnudde, Frank L. Cnudde, Agnes Burkell, Mary Malburg and Lara Eiger; Air Reduction Sales Company, a Delaware Corporation as owners in fee of adjoining property.

Resolved, that all that part of Manor Avenue and all public alleys in blocks bounded by Meyers, Monte Vista, Clarita Avenues and Seven Mile Road more particularly described as that part of Manor Avenue, 60 feet wide, lying between the easterly line of Lot 10; the easterly line of the northerly 21.30 feet of Lot 64; the easterly line of Lots 65 to 70 both inclusive and the westerly line of Lot 11, lots 19 to 24 both inclusive; the westerly line of the northerly 22.04 feet of Lot 25 and between the lines of east and west public alley 20 feet wide all of Marygrove Manor, a subdivision of part of the W. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, T. 1 S., R. 11 E., City of Detroit, Wayne Co., Michigan as recorded in Liber 61, page 67 of Plats of Wayne County Records.

Also all of north and south public alley 20 feet wide lying between easterly line of Lots 71 to 83; the easterly line of the northerly 4.77 feet of Lot 84 and the westerly line of the northerly 20.01 feet of Lot 64; the westerly line of Lots 65 to 70, both inclusive, all of last mentioned subdivision.

Also all of public alley 9 feet wide lying east of and adjoining the easterly line of Lots 19 to 24 both inclusive; the easterly line of the northerly 23.31 feet of Lot 25, all of last mentioned subdivision.

Also all of east and west public alley 20 feet wide lying between the southerly line of Lots 1 to 10, both inclusive, and the northerly line of Lots 70, 71, the northerly line of north and south public alley 20 feet wide heretofore mentioned all of last mentioned subdivision.

Also all of east and west public alley 20 feet wide, lying between the southerly line of Lots 11 to 15, both inclusive, and the northerly line of Lot 19, the northerly line of north and south public alley 9 feet wide heretofore mentioned, all of last mentioned subdivision.

Also all of said public alley 20 feet wide lying south of and adjoining the southerly line of Lots 16 to 18, both inclusive, all of last mentioned Subdivision.

Also all of east and west public alley 20 feet wide being in the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, T. 1 S., R. 11 E., lying between the easterly line of Marygrove Manor, a Subdivision of part of the W. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, T. 1 S., R. 11 E., City of Detroit, Wayne Co., Michigan as recorded in Liber 61, page 67 of Plats of Wayne County Records and the westerly line of Monte Vista
