Resolved, that part of Warsaw Place and alley 1st southerly and parallel thereto between G.T.R.R. R-W and St. Aubin Avenue more particularly described as all of east and west public alley 17.95 feet wide as platted in Harrah and Brandenburg's St. Aubin Avenue Subdivision of part of

Out Lots 46 and 47, St. Aubin Farm and Out Lots 25 Witherell Farm, City of Detroit, Wayne Co., Michigan, as recorded in Liber 18, Page 9 of Plats, of Wayne County Records and lying north of and adjoining the northerly line of Lots 34 ad 35 of last mentioned subdivision.

Also that part of Warsaw Place, 40 feet wide, as platted in Subdivision of Lots 12 and 13 and Lot A of Harrah and Brandenburg's St. Aubin Ave. Subdivision of part of Out Lots 46 and 47 St. Aubin Farm and Out Lot 25, Witherell Farm, City of Detroit, Wayne Co., Michigan, as recorded in Liber 21, Page 98 of Plats of Wayne County Records and lying between the southerly line of Lot 74 and the northerly line of Lot 75 all of last mentioned subdivision.

Be and the same are hereby vacated to become part and parcel of the adjoining property.

Provided, Petitioner pays into the City Treasury the sum of \$285.00, this amount being the estimate cost of relocating a Fire Hydrant in Warsaw Place and to be credited to Account No. 12 (moving Hydrants, etc.) Fire Fund, and further

Provided, Petitioner pays into the City Treasury the sum of \$100.00, this amount being the estimate cost for the relocation of the blow-off at the end of a 6" Water Main in Warsaw Place and to be credited to Water Fund Account No. 512, and further

Provided, Petitioner reimburse the owners to the extent of the value of any utilities now installed in said street and-or alley which it may be necessary to abandon due to the closing of said street and-or alley or bear the entire expense of relocating or re-routing any public utilities now installed in said street and-or alley which it may be necessary to relocate or reroute due to the closing of same, and further

Provided, Petitioner, for himself, his heirs, successors or assigns file with the City Clerk, within thirty days, an agreement in writing waiving any and all claims for damages which may arise due to the separation of grades affecting all of the property herein vacated, and further

Resolved, that upon compliance with the above provisos, the City Controller be and he is hereby directed to issue Quit Claim Deed to Ben Futernick, as owner in fee of adjoining property, and further

Resolved, that upon receipt of proper evidence that all taxes are paid on the abutting property, The City Engineer is hereby directed to release said deeds.
