By Councilman Comstock:

Resolved, That all of north and south public alley, 18 feet wide in block bounded by Rutherford, Prevost, Thatcher and Curtis Avenues, more particularly described as all of said north and south public alley, 9 feet wide as platted in Curtis Heights No. 1 Subn. of E. $\frac{1}{2}$ of N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12, T. 1 S. R. 10 E. City of Detroit, Wayne Co., Mich., as recorded in Liber 62 Page 18 of Plats of Wayne County Records and lying east of and adjoining the easterly line of Lots 135 to 147, both inclusive, all of last mentioned Subdivision.

Also all of said north and south public alley, 9 feet wide as platted in Rugby Boulevard Subdivision of part of the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 12, T. 1 S. R. 10 E., City of Detroit, and Redford Township, Wayne County, Michigan as recorded in Liber 50 Page 56 of Plats of Wayne County Records and lying west of and adjoining the westerly line of Lots 8 to 20, both inclusive, of last mentioned Subdivision.

Be and the same is hereby vacated as a public alley and converted into a public easement which shall be subjected to the agreements, covenants, uses, reservations and regulations as hereinafter set forth, which shall be observed by the owners of said lots heretofore mentioned and by their grantees and assigns, their heirs, successors and assigns forever, to wit:

First, said owners hereby grant to and for the use of the public an easement or right of way over the entire 18 feet of said vacated alley herein described for the purpose of installing, maintaining, repairing, re-draft, telephone, telegraph, electric light or other poles or things usually installed or placed in a public alley in the City of Detroit with the right to ingress and egress at any time to and over said easement for the purposes above set forth;

Second, said owners for their heirs and assigns further agree that no building or structure of any kind whatsoever (except the necessary line fences dividing said Lots) shall be built or placed upon said 18-foot easement or any part thereof so that said easement shall be forever of easy access for the purposes above set forth;

Third, That said easement shall be used for the same purposes for which public alleys are generally used in the City of Detroit excepting that same shall not be opened for the passage of vehicles therein; and further

Provided, Petitioners deposit with the Permit Division of the Department of Public Works the sum of \$56.70, said amount being the estimated cost for the construction of a sidewalk on the north side of Thatcher Avenue within the lines of the alley herein converted into easement; and further

Resolved, That upon compliance with the above provisos the City Controller be and he is hereby directed to issue Quit Claim Deeds to Kenneth D. Holland and Rosemary J. Holland, his wife; Edward T. Walsh and Loretta A. Walsh, his wife; Stanley C. Pomranz and Maurine E. Pomranz, his wife; John W. Brown and Jessie M. Brown, his wife; Clarence E. McGee and Eleanor A. McGee, his wife; Frank Clarkson and Marguerita Clarkson, his wife; Richard E. Vaughn and Betty B. Vaughn, his wife; John M. Diebold and Helen E. Diebold, his wife; William Van Der Sluys and Grace R. Van Der Sluys, his wife; John E. Hooper and Elizabeth M. Hooper, his wife; William R. Everette and Anona I. Everette, his wife; Joseph J. Srp, Jr., and Helen R. Srp, his wife; Walter Woodbridge and Ruth M. Woodbridge, his wife; State of Michigan and Augusta Rea War-nock as owners in fee of adjoining property; and further

Resolved, That upon receipt of proper evidence that all taxes are paid on abutting property the City Engineer is hereby directed to release said deeds.
