Vacation of Alley

To the Honorable, the Common Council:

After consultation with the City Plan Commission, and careful consideration of the request, your committee recommends that same be granted in accordance with the following resolution.

By Councilman Rogell:

Resolved, that all that part of north and south public alley in block bounded by Nottingham Road, Somerset Road, Casino and Moross Road, more particularly described as all that part of north and south public alley, 18 feet wide, lying between the easterly line of lots 1433 to 1441, both inclusive, and the westerly line of lots 1454 to 1462, both inclusive, all of Park Drive Subdn. No. 4 of part of P. C. 123, City of Detroit, Wayne Co., Michigan, as recorded in Liber 54, Page 11 of Plats of Wayne County Records;

Also, all that part of north and south public alley, 18 feet wide, lying between the westerly line of lots 295 to 302, both inclusive, and the easterly line of lots 309 to 322, both inclusive, all of S. C. Hadley's Subdn. of part of P. C. 404, City of Detroit, Wayne Co., Michigan, as recorded in Liber 68, Page 63 of plats of Wayne County Records;

Also, all that part of north and south public alley, 18 feet wide, lying between the easterly line of lots 345 to 353, both inclusive, and the westerly line of lots 354 to 362, both incl., all of Seven Mile-Cadieux Subdivision No. 2, being lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Geo. Prentiss Sub'n of part of rear concession of P. C. 122, City of Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan, as recorded in Liber 54, Page 96 of plats of Wayne County Records.

Be and the same is hereby vacated as a public alley and converted into a public easement, which easement shall be subjected to the following agreements, covenants, uses, reservations and regulations which shall be observed by the owners of said lots and their heirs, executors and administrators and assigns forever, to-wit:

First, said owners hereby grant to and for the use of the public an

easement or right-of-way over said vacated north and south alley herein described for the purpose of installing, maintaining, repairing, removing, or replacing any sewer, conduit, telephone, telegraph, electric light, or other poles or things usually placed or installed in a public alley in the City of Detroit, with the right to ingress and egress at any time to and over said easement for the purposes above set forth;

Second, said owners for their heirs and assigns further agree that no building or structures of any kind whatsoever (except necessary line fences) shall be built or placed upon said easement or any part thereof so that said easement shall be forever of easy access for the purposes named above;

Third, that said easement shall be used for the same purposes for which public alleys are generally used in the City of Detroit, excepting the same shall not be opened for the passage of vehicles therein, and further,

Provided, that by reason of the vacation of the above described alley the City of Detroit does not waive any rights in the lateral sewer located therein and at all times shall have the right to enter the premises, if found necessary, on account of said sewer to repair same, and further

Provided, petitioners reimburse the owners to the extent of the value of any utilities now installed in said alley which it may be necessary to abandon due to the closing of said alley or bear the entire expense of relocating or rerouting any public utilities which it may be necessary to relocate or reroute due to said conversion into easement, and further

Resolved, That upon compliance with the above provisos the City Controller be and he is hereby directed to issue Quit Claim deeds to George J. Hanna and Dona K. Hanna, his wife; Vasil Theodosi and Domnica Theodosi, his wife; Daniel J. Petke and Mabel S. Petke, his wife; Robert Brown and Annie Brown, his wife; Paul L. Heidelberger, administrator of the estate of Anna Heidelberger; John A. Holden and Emily Holden, his wife, Detroit Housing Corporation, a Michigan Corporation; Emil Buydaert; Merry H. Lipp, William J. Bentley and Ann Bentley; his wife; Alberic Couvreur and Gabrielle Couvreur, his wife; Clyde Ireland and Meta C. Ireland, his wife; Charlie Breugelmans; Charles LeFevre and Ida LeFevre, his wife; and Park Drive Development Corporation, a Michigan Corporation; as owners in fee of the adjoining property, and further

Resolved, That upon receipt of proper evidence that all taxes are paid on the abutting property the

City Engineer be and he is hereby directed to release said deeds.
