Gentlemen—In the current fiscal budget, your Honorable Body appropriated the sum of \$4,440.00 in Account 25AAA (9037-219A), Contractual Services for a Sales Director, and \$6,032.00 in Account 25AAA1- (9037-219B), Contractual Services, Maintenance.

Due to the 15 per cent increase in salaries, authorized by your Honorable Body effective January 7, 1946, a deficit of \$350.00 in Account 25AAA (9037-219A) will occur at the end of the fiscal year. Also, due to the acquisition of the Memorial Hall Site, which this office has been designated to maintain, a deficit of \$960.00 in Account 25AAA-1 (9037-219B) will occur because additional help had to be hired.
