To the Honorable, the Common Council:

Gentlemen—We are returning herewith petition of Wolverine Marble Company (No. 7915) requesting the vacation of a portion of the north and south public alley in block bounded by Lumpkin, Fleming, Modern and Jerome Avenues.

The vacation of said portion of alley was approved by the City Plan Commission with the recommendation that the petitioners deed to the City a portion of their property on the west side of Fleming Avenue to be used as an alley outlet in lieu of the alley to be vacated. The petition was then referred to this office by your Committee of the Whole for investigation and report.

Please be advised that all of our investigations are now completed.

As per our directive, the petitioners deposited on September 7, 1948, with the Permit Division of the Department of Public Works the sum of \$1,051.30, Receipt Nos. 84049 and 84050, said amount being the estimated cost of constructing a paved alley return at entrance to alley deeded to the City, stoning said alley and constructing a new sewer manhole south of the alley to be vacated.

We are in receipt of a quit-claim deed from the Wolverine Marble Company deeding land for alley purposes in accordance with the recommendation of the City Plan Commission. Said deed was approved as to form and execution by the Corporation Counsel and as to description by the City Engineer, and we are attaching it hereto for your Honorable Body's acceptance.

All other City departments and private utility companies reported that they will be unaffected by the vacation of this alley, or that they have reached satisfactory agreements with the petitioners regarding their installations therein.

In view of the above, we recommend the adoption of the attached resolution.
