To the Honorable, the Common Council:

Gentlemen—Your Committee of the Whole referred petition of Sohio Fleetwing Inc. et al (No. 4385), requesting the vacation of a surplus portion of Kelly Road between Spring Garden and Morang Avenues to the Department of Public Works for investigation and report. The vacation of said surplus portion of street was previously approved and recommended by the City Plan Commission.

Please be advised that all of our investigations have been completed. In reply to our inquiries all City departments and privately owned utility companies reported that they will be unaffected by the vacation of the portion of street.

As per our directive, on May 23 1949, the petitioners deposited into the City Treasury the sum of \$235.90, Receipt No. 53441, credited to Public Works Maintenance Fund Code No. 143-6221-1, to reimburse the City of Detroit for the original cost of paving Springarden Avenue, at the intersection of the portion of street to be vacated.

In view of the above, we recommend the adoption of the attached resolution.

Department of Public Works

To the Honorable, the Common Council:

Gentlemen—On April 25, 1949 the property owner of lots 514, 515 and 516 of the Homeland Subdivision petitioned the Common Council to have a lateral sewer built in the alley in the block bounded by Lindsay, Gilchrist, south of Vassar, and Vassar Avenues. The Common Council by resolution on May 10th, authorized the Commissioner to prepare plans and a tentative assessment roll. The latter was transmitted to the City Treasurer on May 12th for collection of the 25% deposits required by ordinance. On May 16th, the Unity Construction Company, the owner of the majority of lots in the above mentioned block, petitioned the Common Council to be permitted to construct the sewer privately at their own expense and in accordance with plans and specifications to be prepared by the City Engineer. We have also on file a letter from the first petitioner stating that he has no objection to having the sewer built privately.

In view of the urgency to construct the sewer, so that houses may be built on all of the petitioner's lots, I respectfully submit the following resolution.
