Honorable Common Council:

Gentlemen—Your Committee of the whole referred to this office for investigation and report the petition of Irwin W. Johnson et al (No. 1858), requesting the vacation of the north alley in block bounded. south alley in block bounded by Ardmore, Freeland, St. Martins and Vassar Avenues.

The petitioners have originally requested that only the center 12 feet of the 18 foot alley be converted into an easement so that 3 feet adjoining their lots could be vacated outright.
The City Plan Commission's recommendation was pursuant to this re-In the mentime the local quest. utility companies voiced their objection to such plan of vacation as it would necessitate the removal of their installations, all of which lie within the 3 foot strip adjoining the property lines. The sponsoring petitioner thereupon obtained the consent of all of the owners on both sides of the alley to be vacated to the conversion of the entire alley into an This was discussed with easement. the City Plan Commission and it meets with their approval.

In reply to our inquiries all City departments and privately owned utility companies reported that they have no objection to this change.

The conversion of the alley into an easement conforms with Common Council resolution of November 13, 1943, J.C.C. page 2230.

We recommend the adoption of the

Resolved, That all of north-south public alley, 18 feet wide, in block bounded by Freeland, Ardmore, Vassar and St. Martins Avenues, platted in San Bernardo Park No. 1, a subdivision of the E. $\frac{1}{2}$ of W. $\frac{1}{2}$ of S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, T. 1 S., R. 11 E., as recorded in Liber 49 of plats, Page 13, Wayne County Records, lying east of and adjoining the east line of lots 338 to 347, both inclusive, and west of and adjoining the west line of lots 380 to 389, both inclusive, all lots mentioned being the same as platted in last mentioned subdivision.

Be and the same is hereby vacated as a public alley and converted into a public easement, which easement shall be subject to the following agreements, covenants, uses, reservations and regulations which shall be Observed by the owners of said lots and by their grantees and assigns, and their heirs, executors, admin-

istrators and assigns, forever to-wit: First, said owners hereby grant to and for the use of the public an Co., \$15,894.50.

easement or right of way over said vacated public alley, hereinabove described, for the purpose of installing, maintaining, repairing, removing or replacing any sewer, conduit, telephone, telegraph, electric light, or other poles or things usually placed or installed in a public alley in the City of Detroit, with the right to ingress or egress at any time to and over said easement for the purposes above set forth;

Second, said owners for their heirs assigns further agree that no buildings or structures of any nature whatsoever, (except necessary line fences) shall be built or placed upon said easement or any part thereof, so that said easement shall be forever of easy access for the purposes named above

Third, that said easement shall be used for the same purposes for which public alleys are generally used in the City of Detroit, excepting the same shall not be opened for the passage of vehicles therein.
