Calvert's Sons Van Dyke Sub-division as recorded in Liber 54 of plats, Page 59, Wayne County Records, lying south of and adjoining the south line of lots 364 to 379, both inclusive, and north of and adjoining the north line of lots 308 to 323, both inclusive, of last mentioned subdivision, be and the same is vacated as public alley and is hereby con-verted into public easement of the full width of the alley, which easement shall be subject to the followhg covenants, agreements, uses, reser-Valions and regulations which shall be observed by the owners of the lots abutting on said alley, and by their stantees and assigns, and their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, to-wit:
