Councilman Van Antwerp then moved that the motion to reconsider be indefinitely postponed, which motion prevailed.

The regular order was resumed.

Honorable Common Council:

Gentlemen—Your Committee of the Whole referred to this office for investigation and report the recommendation of the City Plan Commission that Bates Street between Jefferson Avenue and Larned Street and the alleys in blocks bounded by Jefferson, Larned, Randolph and Woodward Avenues be vacated, said street and alleys being within the limits of the City-County Building

Our investigations are completed and they disclose that various City departments and privately owned utility companies are affected by the vacations to a considerable extent, Bates Street being a central route for an important network of water mains, conduits. etc.

In order that the continued use of the present installations be not disrupted and yet to prevent the installation of additional facilities, we believe a resolution vacating the street and alleys should be adopted at this time. The vacation of the street and allevs would also permit the use of the site as a compact unit for any number of uses in the interim prior to the actual construction of the City—County Building.
The matter of reimbursing th

various City departments whose installations will have to be rerouted may be taken up at such time as the City-County Building Authority requests the relocation of the facilities.

We recommend the adoption of the attached resolution.
