Gentlemen—We wish to inform your Honorable Body that on September 24, 1954 two orders were signed by the Honorable Vincent M. Brennan, Wayne Circuit Judge, vacating two alleys located in the City of Detroit and bounded by the following streets or avenues:

Case No. 277,767 — Patton, Fielding, Constance and VanBuren Avenues (Petition No. 7051)

Case No. 277,768 — Brock, Salter, Seymour and Spring Garden Avenues (Petition No. 7319).

The orders provide that a public easement for public utility purposes be retained in the lands formerly comprising the alleys.

We submit herewith for your consideration a resolution directing the City Clerk to record the attached true copies of the orders with the Wayne County Register of Deeds, pursuant to the order of the Court.
