Honorable Common Council:
Gentlemen—Your Committee of the
Whole referred to this office for in-
vestigation and report the petition
of the Atlas Finance Company, Peti-
tion No. 986 requesting the vacation
of the 20 foot north-south public
alley, north of Flanders Avenue, be-
tween Hayes Avenue and Kelly Road.
The vacation of said alley was ap-
proved by the City Plan Commission.
We wish to advise that our investi-
gations are completed.

A proper provision is incorporated
into the vacating resolution protect-
ing the City's interests in the sewer
located in the portion of alley to be
vacated.

All other City departments and
privately owned utility companies
reported that they will be unaffected
by the vacation of said alley or that
they have reached satisfactory agree-
ments with the petitioners regarding
their installations therein.

We recommend the adoption of the
attached resolution.

Resolved, That all of the north-
south public alley 20 feet wide, lying
north of Flanders Avenue, between
Hayes Avenue and Kelly Road, as
platted in Barber's Houston Avenue
Subdivision of part of Private Claim
231, Gratiot Township, Wayne County,
Mich., as recorded in Liber 48, Page
48 of Plats, Wayne County Records,
lying east of and adjoining the east
line of lots 7 to 11 both inclusive
and west of and adjoining the west
line of lots 25 to 29 both inclusive
of the above mentioned subdivision,
be and the same is hereby vacated as
a public alley to become a part and
parcel of adjoining property subject
to the following provisions:

1) Provided, That by reason of the
vacation of the above described alley,
the City of Detroit does not waive
any rights to the sewer located therein
and at all times shall have the right
to enter upon the premises, if found
necessary, on account of said sewer
to repair, alter, or service same; and
further

2) Provided, That if a building is
to be constructed over said sewer, the
sewer shall be replaced with cast iron
pipe of the same size, rerouted or
encased in 6 inches of Class "A" con-
crete, or in lieu of the above, such

work shall be done as will be speci-
fied by the City Engineer, all of the
supervision and inspection of the
Department of Public Works and all
costs entailed to be borne by the
petitioners, their successors, or as-
signs; and further

3) Provided, That no buildings shall
be constructed over said sewer with-
out the prior approval of such build-
ing construction by the City Engineer
and the Department of Buildings and
Safety Engineering; and further

4) Provided, That in the event that
the sewer located in said alley, if
built upon, shall break causing dam-
age to any construction above, the
petitioner and their assigns, by accep-
tance of the permit for building
over said sewer, waive all claims for
damages to such construction and
agree to pay all costs incident to the
repair of said broken sewer.
