Gentlemen—During the period May 7, 1955, through May 13, 1955, the Controller invested funds totaling \$3,400,000 in U. S. Treasury Bills. All investments were authorized under resolution adopted by your Honorable Body on June 8, 1954.

The investments in detail were as follows:

General Invested Funds—

Par Value \$1,500,000. Due July 7, 1955, Cost \$1,496,912.50, at 99.794167; Yield 1.30%.

Water Invested Funds—

Par Value \$400,000. Due August 4, 1955, Cost \$398,730.67, at 99.6826667; Yield 1.36%.

General Public Improvement Bond Fund—

Par Value \$1,000,000. Due August 11, 1955, Cost \$996,511.67, at 99.651167; Yield 1.38%.

Par Value \$500,000. Due June 23, 1955, Cost \$499,327.78, at 99.865556; Yield 1.10%.

Total Par Value \$3,400,000.

Total Cost \$3,391,482.62.

Gentlemen—This is to inform your Honorable Body that on May 10, 1955, an Order was signed by Hon. George Edwards, Wayne Circuit Judge, vacating the alley located in the City of Detroit and bounded by Shirley Avenue, Schaefer Highway, Castleton, and Capitol Avenues. Common Council Petition No. 2691.

The Order provides that a public easement for public utility purposes be retained in the lands formerly comprising the alley.
