Honorable Common Council:

Gentlemen—The City of Detroit acquired the property known as 522 Howard and 528-530 Howard Street on April 1, 1955 through condemnation for the site of a parking structure in the area bounded by First, Second, Howard and Abbott Streets.

The property was owned by Jack Mamassian and operated as rooming houses. Rent was established by this office at the rate of \$375.00 per month, based on full occupancy by roomers.

Pursuant to a directive of your Honorable Body dated July 12, 1955, J.C.C. Page 1458, Notice to Vacate the premises by September 15, 1955 was served on July 20, 1955, and the tenant immediately began to comply with our request by notifying his sub-tenants to move. Full rent was charged by this office for the months of July and August, and Mr. Mamassian protested that the buildings were only partially occupied and requested a reduction on this basis. We have reviewed his statements and feel that a reduction is justified in the amount of \$368.50.

If your Honorable Body concurs, we submit the attached resolution for your consideration.
