Resolved, That the City Engineer be and he is hereby authorized and directed to prepare the necessary plans and specifications for the installation of a lateral sewer in Lahser Road, north of Verne Avenue, showing the property to be benefited and the estimated cost thereof and to prepare a tentative assessment roll based on said estimates, and to transmit said tentative assessment rolls to the City Treasurer for proposed Lateral Sewer No. 6938, who shall proceed to collect in advance not less than 25% of the City's estimated cost of the proposed improvement from the parties benefiting therefrom within 60 days after receipt of said tentative assessment roll, in accordance with Chapter 56 of the Compiled Ordinances of the City of Detroit for the year 1945 as amended.
