Gentlemen — In 1943 the United States Public Housing Administration acquired a leasehold in the following described property by virtue of condemnation proceedings, U. S. Civil Action No. 3784, MICH-20045:

All streets and alleys in the vicinity of Griggs, Wyoming, Pembroke and Eight Mile Road, formerly known as Brooks Addition temporary housing project.

This parcel was dismissed by court order May 15, 1956.

The United States Attorney's Office has advised that there is on deposit the total sum of \$12.00, representing rent at the rate of \$1.00 per annum from May 15, 1944, to May 15, 1956. (Rent for the period from May 15, 1943, to May 15, 1944, was paid in December, 1945).

We recommend that the above rental payment be approved and the City Controller be authorized to execute the rental stipulation when presented.
