To be used for general boat purposes and mooring at a rental of \$1,900 per month during June, July and August and \$300 per month during September through May.

(2) The East 420 feet of that part of the Civic Center south of Atwater Street, west of Woodward Avenue, except the East 100 feet, except the West 135 feet of the East 235 feet of the North 110 feet, except the West 85 feet of the East 420 feet of the North 130 feet, to be used for parking purposes at a rental of \$2,750 per month.

**Chicago, Duluth and Georgian Bay Company—**

(1) Property described as: All that part of Lots 186, 187 and 188, Section 4, Governor and Judges Plan of City of Detroit, lying south of the Civic Center By-Pass Roadway.

(2) Rental of \$540 per month during April through September, and rental of \$100 per month during October through March.

Both leases to be subject to all other conditions of the present lease not conflicting and as provided in the resolutions of March 24, 1953, (J.C.C. Pages 614-15) and August 7, 1956, (J.C.C. 1718).
