Gentlemen—Your Committee of the Whole referred to this office for investigation and report the petition of Mrs. Marshall L. Keller, No. 1339, requesting the vacation of a portion of easement located east of Cheyenne Avenue, north of Pembroke Avenue. The vacation of said easement was approved by the City Plan Commission in their letter to your Honorable Body of June 19, 1959.

We wish to advise that our investigations are completed.

As per our directive, the petitioner deposited with the City Treasurer the sum of \$195.00, Receipt No. D-1356, credited to the Public Lighting Commission Fund Code No. 990-9423, said amount being the estimated costs of moving Public Lighting Commission street lighting and communication wires from the easement to be vacated.

The petitioner also deposited with the City Treasurer the sum of \$75.00, Receipt No. D-1357, credited to the Detroit Police Department, Fund Code No. 990-9418, said amount being the estimated cost of moving communication wires used by the Detroit Police Department from the easement to be vacated.

All other City departments and privately owned utility companies reported that they will be unaffected by the vacation of said easement.

We recommend the adoption of the attached resolution.

Gentlemen—We are returning herewith the petition of St. Joseph's Mercy Hospital of Detroit, No. 3508, requesting the vacation of a portion of the east-west alley in the block bounded by East Grand Blvd., Elmwood, Milwaukee and Sargent Avenues. The vacation of said alley was approved by the City Plan Commission and the petition was referred to this office by your Committee of the Whole for investigation and report.

We wish to advise that our investigations are completed.

As per our directive, the petitioner deposited with the City Treasurer the sum of \$75.73, Receipt No. D-1358, credited to the Street Maintenance, Fund Code No. 143-6241, said amount being the original cost of paving the west one-half of Elmwood Avenue at the intersection of the alley to be vacated.

The petitioner requested that the paved alley return at the entrance to the alley to be vacated remain in its present status as the petitioner plans to utilize same, and has agreed by letter filed with the original petition to pay all costs incidental to the removal of the returns at such time in the future as the removal becomes necessary.

Proper provisions are incorporated into the vacating resolution protecting the City's interests in the sewers located in the above mentioned alley to be vacated.

All other City departments and privately owned companies reported that they will be unaffected by the vacation of said alley or that they have reached satisfactory agreements with the petitioner regarding their installations therein.

We recommend the adoption of the attached resolution.

Resolved, That all that part of the east-west public alley, 12 feet wide, west of Elmwood Avenue, between Milwaukee and Sargent Avenues, as platted in Block 3 of Kengels Subdivision of that part of Outlot No. 11, subdivision of Fractional Sections 29 and 32, T. 1 S., R. 12 E., as recorded in Liber 9, Page 12 of Plats, Wayne County Records, lying north of and adjoining the north line of Lots 9 and 10 and south of and adjoining the south line of Lots 7 and 8, all of the above mentioned subdivision, be and the same is hereby vacated as a public alley to become a part and parcel of the adjoining property subject to the following provisions:
