Whereas, the Common Council did by resolution on May 10, 1960, (J.C.C. Page 817), approve the acquisition of land and permanent rights-of-way for Department of Water Supply and other Municipal Public Purposes (Booster Station); Now, Therefore Be It

Resolved, That it is hereby declared necessary by the Common Council of the City of Detroit to make the following described improvement in the City of Dearborn, County of Wayne, and that the same is for the use or benefit of the public, viz: Acquisition of land and permanent rights-of-way for Department of Water Supply and other Municipal Public Purposes (Booster Station), and that they deem it necessary to take private property for the purpose of making such improvement, which said property is situated in said City of Dearborn, County of Wayne, and located in area of Inkster and Beech Daly Roads, and described as follows:
