Gentlemen-We are returning herewith the petition of the Detroit Housing Commission requesting the vacation of Fifth Street north of Lafayette Avenue and the east-west public alley north of Lafayette Avenue between Sixth and Fifth Streets in connection with the redevelopment of the West Side Industrial Project. The vacation

of said street and alley was approved by the City Plan Commission and the petition was then referred to this office by your Committee of the Whole for investigation and report.

We wish to advise that our investi-

gations are completed.

As per our directive the petitioner issued a purchase order (No. S-2272), in favor of the Department of Water Supply, to cover costs of relocating water mains necessitated by the vacation of said street and alley.

The petitioner also issued a purchase order (No. S-2273), in favor of the Fire Department, to cover costs of removing and relocating two fire hydrants necessitated by the vacation
