Gentlemen—Your Honorable Body authorized me to negotiate an agreement with the City of Dearborn in the matter of the enclosure of Baby Creek and the construction of the Wyoming Relief Sewer, Kirkwood to Belton (J.C.C. 2112, 1959).

The agreement has been prepared and approved as to form by the Corporation Counsel. Essentially agreement sets forth the apportionthe ment of cost between Dearborn and Detroit with respect to the enclosure of Baby Creek. The contribution of each municipality toward this part of the construction of the Baby Creek Sewer is based upon the percentage of flow that each municipality will discharge from areas tributary to the Baby Creek Sewer. In addition, the agreement establishes the right of Detroit to construct the Wyoming Relief Sewer through Dearborn, and a reciprocal right for Dearborn to construct a future sewer within Detroit limits to carry flow from area tributary to the Baby Creek Sewer Wyoming Avenue Trunk Sewer.

I respectfully request your authorization to sign this agreement in behalf of the City, and at such time as the agreement is fully executed, it will be presented to your Honorable Body for approval and confirmation.
