Honorable Common Council:

Gentlemen—Contract PW-3114 is for the Paving of Concrete Sidewalks and Driveways in Group 105. Hartwell Construction Company is the Contractor. This Contract is on a unit price basis with estimated quantities of various items of work stated in the Proposal.

Since the award of this Contract on June 21, 1960, certain additional work has been requested by petitions, while certain other items of the original work are not now required. This additional work would increase the 4-inch sidewalks from the previously approved adjusted quantity of 56,000 square feet to 61,000 square feet. The previously approved adjusted quantity of 6-inch driveways from 2,885 square feet to 3,385 square feet. The 8-inch driveways would be decreased from 400 square feet to 120 square feet of the previously approved adjusted quantity.

It is, therefore, recommended that the additional work be added as an extra to Contract PW-3114 in accordance with the Contract provisions for changes in the work. The net increase in the Contract Price by reason of the changes in the work is \$2,284.00. Funds are presently available to cover the increase in cost.
