Honorable Common Council:
Gentlemen—A review of the relief sewer program in the area traversed by the John Lodge Expressway Extension has indicated the desirability of building the portion of the future Hubbell Avenue Relief Sewer passing under the expressway at Hubbell Avenue, simultaneously with the expressway construction.

Building this portion of the future relief sewer in conjunction with the expressway construction will result in a lower cost to the City than would be the case at some future date when traffic is traveling over the expressway. The estimated cost of this section of 8 foot sewer is \$60,000.

We respectfully request the authority of your Honorable Body to arrange with the State Highway Department for the construction of the section of sewer as outlined above and to reimburse the Detroit Expressway Construction Fund for the actual construction cost of the sewer, when the sewer has been completed, from available Sewer Bond Funds.

Honorable Common Council:
Gentlemen—We wish to advise that in carrying out the development plan for the rehabilitation of the blighted area which is known as the West Side Industrial Project, which is being undertaken by the City pursuant to Act 344 of Public Acts of 1945, as amended, the Detroit Housing Commission has requested the vacation of the remaining streets and alleys within the proposed West Side Industrial Subdivision No. 2.

The Detroit Edison Company has reported that it has lines and poles in the streets and alleys to be vacated and has submitted an estimate of

\$35,867.89, as its entire cost of removing and rerouting its installations from the streets and alleys to be vacated within the limits of the proposed West Side Industrial Subdivision No. 2.

The Michigan Consolidated Gas Company has reported that it will be necessary to relocate a 4 inch service line which is located in Eighth Street to be vacated at an estimated cost of \$1,680.00.

Your Honorable Body may make provisions for the relocation of the lines and poles of the Detroit Edison Company and the Michigan Consolidated Gas Company in streets located near the streets and alleys to be vacated.

We have been advised by the Office of the Corporation Counsel that since the vacation of these streets and alleys are necessary to carry out the development plan for the rehabilitation of this blighted area, that the relocation costs of these utilities is not chargeable against the City.

All other City departments and privately owned utility companies reported that they will be unaffected by the vacation of said streets and alleys.

In view of the foregoing, it will be necessary to adopt a resolution vacating the aforementioned streets and alleys and directing the Detroit Edison Company and the Michigan Consolidated Gas Company to remove their pipes, lines, and poles therefrom.

Whereas, The City is undertaking the rehabilitation of a blighted area known as the West Side Industrial Project, pursuant to Act 344 of the Public Acts of 1945, as amended, and Whereas, in order to carry out the development plan for the project, it is necessary among other things for the City to vacate the following streets and alleys:

All of Eighth Street, 50 feet wide, between the south line of Porter Street, 60 feet wide and the north line of Abbott Street, 50 feet wide, as platted in the Subdivision of the Farm of Col. D. Baker, as divided into City Lots by John Mullett, as recorded in Liber 17, Page 272 of Deeds Wayne County Records, lying west of and adjoining the west line of Lots 7 and 8, west of adjoining the 20-foot alley lying between said Lots 7 and 8 and west of and adjoining the west line of the vacated north 5.00 feet of Abbott Street, all of Block 51 of the above-mentioned subdivision and lying east of and adjoining the east line of Lots 1 and 14, east of and adjoining the east line of the 20-foot alley lying between

said Lots 1 and 14, and east of and adjoining the east line of the vacated north 5.00 feet of Abbott Street, all of Block 61 of the above-mentioned subdivision.

Also the west 12.50 feet of Brooklyn Avenue, 50 feet wide, between the south line of Porter Street, 60 feet wide and the north line of Abbott Street, 50 feet wide, lying east of and adjoining the east line of Lots 1 and 14, east of and adjoining the east line of the 20-foot alley lying between said Lots 1 and 14, and east of and adjoining the east line of the north 5.00 feet of vacated Abbott Street, all of Block 51 of the Plat of the Labrosse Farm South of Chicago Road, as recorded in Liber 13, Page 85 of Deeds Wayne County Records.

Also the east 12.50 feet of Brooklyn Avenue, 50 feet wide, between the south line of Porter Street, 60 feet wide, and the north line of Abbott Street, 50 feet wide, lying west of and adjoining the west line of Lots 7 and 8, west of and adjoining the west line of the 20-foot alley lying between said Lots 7 and 8 and west of and adjoining the west line of the north 5.00 feet of vacated Abbott Street all of Block 50 of the Plat of the Labrosse Farm South of Chicago Road, as recorded in Liber 13, Page 85, of Deeds Wayne County Records.

Also the north 5.00 feet of Abbott Street, 60 feet wide between the east line of Brooklyn Avenue, 50 feet wide, and the west line of Sixth Street, 50 feet wide, as platted in Block 50 of said Plat of the Labrosse Farm, as recorded in Liber 13, Page 85 of Deeds Wayne County Records lying south of and adjoining the south line of Lots 8 to 14, both inclusive of the above-mentioned subdivision.

Also the north 5.00 feet of Abbott Street, 55 feet wide, between the east line of Eighth Street, 50 feet wide and the west line of Brooklyn Avenue, 50 feet wide, lying south of and adjoining the south line of Lots 8 to 14, both inclusive of Block 51 of the Subdivision of the Farm of Col. Records.

Also the north 5.00 feet of Abbott Street, 55 feet wide, west of the west line of Tenth Street, 50 feet wide, lying south of and adjoining the south line of Lots 10 to 14, both inclusive of Block 69 of the Subdivision of the Woodbridge Farm, as recorded in Liber 1, Pages 146 and 147 of Plats Wayne County Records, lying south of and adjoining the south line of Lots 7 to 9, both inclusive of George L. Beecher's Subdivision, as recorded in Liber 22, Page 76 of Plats Wayne County Records, and lying south of and adjoining the south line of Lots 13 and 14 of Outlot 6, south of and adjoining the south line of Lot 13 of Outlot 7 and south of and adjoining the south line of the east 18.28 feet of Lot 14 of Outlot 7 of Specht's Subdivision, as recorded in Liber 65, Page 142 of Deeds Wayne County Records.

Also the north 5.00 feet of Labrosse Street, 60 feet wide, between the east line of Tenth Street, 50 feet wide and west line of Trumbull Avenue, 100 feet wide, lying south of and adjoining the south line of Lots 8 to 14, both inclusive of Block 74 of the Plat of the Woodbridge Farm, as recorded in Liber 1, Pages 146 and 147 of Plats Wayne County Records.

Also the north 5.00 feet of Labrosse Street, 60 feet wide, lying west of the west line of Tenth Street, 50 feet wide, lying south of and adjoining the south line of Lots 12, 13 and 14 of Block 75 of the Plat of the Woodbridge Farm as recorded in Liber 1, Pages 146 and 147 of Plats Wayne County Records, lying south of and adjoining the south line of Lots 19, 20 and 21 of Luther Beecher's Subdivision, as recorded in Liber 2, Page 27 of Plats Wayne County Records, lying south of and adjoining the south line of Lot 21 of Outlot 6 and south of and adjoining the south line of Lot 21 of Outlot 7 of Specht's Subdivision, as recorded in Liber 65, Page 142 of Deeds Wayne County Records, lying south of and adjoining the south line of Lots 56 to 61, both inclusive of the Subdivision of Lot 2 of Subdivision of P.C. 27, Lognon Farm, as recorded in Liber 137, Page 70 of Deeds Wayne County Records.

Also all that part of the east-west public alley, 20 feet wide, west of Tenth Street between Bagley and Labrosse Streets as platted in Block 75 of the Plat of the Woodbridge Farm, as recorded in Liber 1, Pages 146 and 147 of Plats Wayne County Records and Chancery File 2526, lying south of and adjoining the south line of Lots 1, 2 and 3, and north of and adjoining the north line of Lots 12, 13 and 14, of the above mentioned Subdivision.

Also the south 10.00 feet of the 20 foot public alley north of Porter Street between Tenth Street and Trumbull Avenue lying north of and adjoining the north line of Lots 8 to 14 both inclusive of Block 71 of the Subdivision of the Woodbridge Farm, as recorded in Liber 1, Pages 146 and 147 of Plats Wayne County Records, therefore, be it

Resolved, That all of the above described streets and alleys are hereby vacated as public streets and alleys to become a part and parcel of the adjoining property; and be it further

Resolved, That upon the proper application, the Department of Public Works shall issue to the Detroit Edison Company and the Michigan Consolidated Gas Company permits to re-locate their pipes, poles and lines from the vacated streets and alleys to public streets most conveniently located in reference to the vacated streets and alleys and consistent with the public health, safety, convenience and general welfare; and be it further

Resolved, That the Detroit Edison Company and the Michigan Consolidated Gas Company are hereby di-

rected to remove all their pipes, poles and wires from the vacated streets and alleys without expense to the City within thirty (30) days after receipt of a copy of this resolution; and be it further

Resolved, That the City Clerk is hereby directed to mail to the Detroit Edison Company, the Michigan Consolidated Gas Company and the Michigan Bell Telephone Company, a certified copy of this resolution; and further

Resolved, That all of Tenth Street, 50 feet wide, between the south line of Bagley Street, 60 feet wide, and the north line of Labrosse Street, 50 feet wide, as platted in the Subdivision of the Woodbridge Farm as recorded in Liber 1, Pages 146 and 147 of Plats Wayne County Records, lying east of and adjoining the east line of Lots 1 and 14, east of and adjoining the east line of the 20 foot alley lying between said Lots 1 and 14 and east of and adjoining the east line of the north 5.00 feet of vacated Labrosse Street, all of Block 75 of said Woodbridge Farm, lying west of and adjoining the west line of Lots 7 and 8, west of and adjoining the west line of the 20 foot alley lying between said Lots 7 and 8 and west of and adjoining the west line of the north 5.00 feet of vacated Labrosse Street, all of Block 74 of said Woodbridge Farm.

Also all of Tenth Street, 50 feet wide, between the south line of Labrosse Street, 50 feet wide, and the north line of Porter Street, 60 feet wide, as platted in the Subdivision of the Woodbridge Farm as recorded in Liber 1, Pages 146 and 147 of Plats Wayne County Records, lying east of and adjoining the east line of Lots 1 and 14, east of and adjoining the east line of the 20 foot alley lying between said Lots 1 and 14 and east of and adjoining the east line of the south 5.00 feet of vacated Labrosse Street, all of Block 70 of said Woodbridge Farm, lying west of and adjoining the west line of Lots 7 and 8, west of and adjoining the west line of the 20 foot alley lying between said Lots 7 and 8 and west of and adjoining the west line of the south 5.00 feet of vacated Labrosse Street, all of Block 71 of said Woodbridge Farm.

Also all of Abbott Street, 60 feet wide, between Sixth Street and a line extending from the southeast corner of Lot 10 of Block 49 of said Subdivision of the Labrosse Farm as recorded in Liber 13, Page 85 of Deeds, Wayne County Records, to a point in the northerly line of Lot 4 of Block 41 of said Subdivision of the Labrosse Farm, said point being easterly 44.07 feet from the northwest corner of said Lot 4, lying south of and adjoining the south line of Lots 8 to 10 both inclusive, lying north of and

adjoining the north line of Lots 5 to 7 both inclusive and north of and adjoining the north line of the west 44.07 feet of Lot 4, all being platted in said Subdivision of the Labrosse Farm.

Also the west 25.00 feet of the east 37.50 feet of Brooklyn Avenue, 50 feet wide between the south line of Porter Street, 60 feet wide, and the north line of Abbott Street, 50 feet wide, as platted in Block 50 of the Subdivision of the Labrosse Farm, as recorded in Liber 13, Page 85 of Deeds Wayne County Records.

Also the north 10.00 feet of the 20 foot alley south of Labrosse Street and east of Tenth Street, lying south of and adjoining the south line of Lots 5 to 7 both inclusive of Block 71 of the Subdivision of the Woodbridge Farm as recorded in Liber 1, Pages 146 and 147 of Plats Wayne County Records.

Be and the same are hereby vacated as public streets and alleys to become a part and parcel of the adjoining property subject to the following reservations:

1) Underground easements are hereby reserved within the right-of-way of said streets and alleys hereinabove described for public utilities.

2) The right of ingress and egress to and over said easements for the purpose of installing, maintaining, repairing, removing or replacing public utilities.

3) Public utilities shall not be installed on surface but only underground and no buildings or structures of any nature whatsoever (except necessary line fences) shall be built or placed upon said easements, and further

Resolved, That the Detroit Edison Company and the Michigan Bell Telephone Company are hereby directed to remove all their overhead poles and wires from the vacated streets and alleys without expense to the City within thirty (30) days after receipt of a copy of this resolution; and be it further

Resolved, That the City Clerk is hereby directed to mail to the Detroit Edison Company, the Michigan Consolidated Gas Company and the Michigan Bell Telephone Company, a certified copy of this resolution.
