Gentlemen—Contract PW-5713 is for Lateral Sewer 7117 in Dolson from Fullerton to Glendale. Claerhout Brothers Construction, Inc., is the Contractor.

The Contract does not provide for partial payments and, as the balance of the work remaining consists of

sidewalk repairs and final clean-up which will be performed in the spring of 1966, the Contractor has requested partial payment.

The total value of the work fully completed and found acceptable, under the terms and conditions of the Contract, is \$11,748.00, and it is recommended that authority be granted to pay this amount, less a retained amount of \$1,200.00, making a net payment at this time of \$10,548.00.

The Contractor has submitted an affidavit that all payrolls, material bills, and all other indebtedness incurred by him in connection with the work have been paid, except items specifically listed as unpaid.

The \$1,200.00 to be retained is in excess of the estimated value of the uncompleted work.

Honorable Common Council:

Gentlemen—Contract PW-4580 is for the Southfield Relief Arm, West McNichols to Curtis. DiMambro Contractors, Inc. is the contractor.

All work under the contract is substantially completed, with the exception of pavement restoration in Southfield Road and some sidewalk and lawn repairs at several locations. This work will be completed in the spring of 1966 when proper weather conditions allow.

The contractor has requested that the amount retained on completed work be reduced to a lump sum of \$4,000.00. The value of work completed to date and found acceptable, under the terms and conditions of the contract, is \$315,722.00 and it is recommended that authority be granted to pay that amount, less the \$4,000.00 retained, and less all previous payments, which results in a net payment at this time of \$11,800.00.

The contractor has submitted an affidavit that all payrolls, material bills and other indebtedness have been paid.
