Gentlemen—Petition No. 397 of White Pine Sales Company requests the vacation of a portion of the east-west public easement, 20 feet wide, north of Fitzpatrick Avenue, west of Brace Avenue. The requested vacation was approved by the City Plan Commission, and then referred to this department for investigation and report. This has been completed and the petition is returned herewith.

The Sewer Design Bureau of the Department of Public Works has reported that they have no objections to the vacation of a portion of said easement provided the petitioner constructs a new manhole in accordance with plans approved by the Department of Public Works and under City specifications and inspection.

The petitioner has deposited a certified check in the amount of \$2,000.00, Receipt No. GR-13523, to guarantee construction of the above mentioned manhole and shall be redeemable upon completion of construction.

All other City departments and privately owned utility companies reported that they will be unaffected by the vacation of said easement or that they have reached satisfactory agreements with the petitioner regarding their installations therein.
