Honorable Common Council:

Re: Petition No. 6609, The Detroit Board of Education, Vacation of the Alleys bounded by Ohio, Cherrylawn, Fullerton, and Buena Vista; and Ohio Avenue between Fullerton & Buena Vista Avenues.

Gentlemen-The above petition requests the vacation of the alleys in the above mentioned blocks, and the conversion to easement for public utilities of Ohio Avenue between Fullerton and Buena Vista Avenues.

The requested vacation and conversion into easement for subsurface public utilities were recommended by the City Plan Commission. The petition was then referred to us for investigation and report. Our report, accompanied by the original petition is as follows:

The petitioner has issued the following purchase orders which have purchase orders which have been credited to the departments and accounts named, for the purposes indicated:

Department of Water Supply (Sewer Maintenance Division)

Purchase Order No. 12943, \$400.00. For the estimated cost of disconnecting water services in the area to be vacated.

Fire Department

Purchase Order No. 12941, \$1,070.00. For the estimated cost to relocate one fire hydrant.

Public Lighting Commission

Purchase Order No. 12940, \$5,250.00. For the estimated cost of relocating street lighting equipment.

Department of Public Works—Street

**Maintenance Division** 

Purchase Order No. 12939, \$3,000.00. For the estimated cost of pavement removal and sidewalk and curb construction at the intersection of streets to be vacated.

Department of Public Works-Intersection Fund

Purchase Order No. 23340, \$1,350.00. For the original cost of paving the reets at the intersection of the streets at the intersection of street and alleys to be vacated.

Proper provisions are incorporated into the vacating resolution protecting the City's interest in sewers lo-cated or to be located in the public

rights-of-way to be vacated.

All City departments and privatelyowned utility companies reported that they will be unaffected by the vacation and conversion to an easement of said street and alley or that they have reached satisfactory agreements the petitioner regarding their installation therein.

Be and the same are hereby vacated as a public street and is hereby converted into a public easement for subsurface utilities of the full width of the street, which easement shall be subject to the following convenants and agreements, uses, reservations and regulations, which shall be observed by the owners of the lots abutting on said street and by their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever to wit:

First, said owners hereby grant to and for the use of the public easements or right-of-way under said vacated public street hereinabove described for the purpose of maintaining, installing, repairing, removing, or replacing public utilities such as water mains, sewers, gas lines or mains, telephone, electric light conduits or things usually placed or installed under a public street in the city of Detroit, with the right to the paved alley returns in the alleys

ingress and egress at any time to and over said easement for the purpose above set forth.

Second, said owners for their heirs and assigns further agree that no buildings or structures of any nature whatsoever including but not limited to concrete slabs or driveways, retaining or partition walls (except necessary line fence) shall be built or placed upon said easement, nor any change of surface grade made, without prior approval by the Department of Public Works.

Third, that if any time in the future the owners of any lots abutting on said vacated street shall request the removal and-or relocation of any existing utilities in said easement, such owners, upon whose property the utilities are located shall pay all costs incident to such removal and-or relocation, unless such charges are waived by the utility owners.

Fourth, that if any utility located or to be located in said property shall break or be damaged as a result of any action on the part of the petitioner or assigns (by way of illustration but not limitation), such as storage of excessive wieghts of materials or construction not in accordance with Section 2, mentioned above, then in such event the petitioner or assigns shall be liable for all costs incidental to the repair of such broken or damaged utility.
