Honorable Common Council:

Re: Granting an Easement for Detroit Metropolitan Water Services in Elmwood Park No. 2.

Gentlemen—The developers of the Ralph Bunche Homes in Elmwood Park No. 2 propose to utilize approximately 550 feet of eight inch water main in vacated Fort Street, west of Joseph Campau, as a section in the projects proposed water distribution system.

Consequently the Detroit Metropolitan Water Services has requested that the resolution adopted by your Honorable Body on November 5, 1969, J.C.C. Pages 2734 to 2745 be amended to grant them an easement in the southerly 20 feet of Fort Street, 50 feet wide, for a distance of

approximately 118 feet westerly from the westerly line of Joseph Campau.

The Detroit Housing Commission has approved the grant of the easement.

We respectfully request your Honorable Body to adopt the attached resolution granting the easement.

Resolved, That for reasons of granting an easement for the Detroit Metropolitan Water Services in Fort Street the resolution granting the Detroit Housing Commission's petition (No. 7237) passed on November 5, 1969, J.C.C. pages 2734 to 2745 is amended by the deletion of the following paragraph and the addition of new paragraphs:

Page 2739, Paragraph 5, being:

"Resolved, That the above described streets and alleys are hereby vacated as public streets and alleys to become a part and parcel of the adjoining property; and be it further"

Be and the same is hereby rescinded and is hereby replaced by the following:

"Resolved, That the above described streets and alleys are hereby vacated as public streets and alleys to become a part and parcel of the adjoining property subject to the following easement provisions:

A 20 foot easement is reserved for the Detroit Metropolitan Water Services in the southerly 20 feet of Fort Street, 50 feet wide, abutting the northerly line of lot 1 and part of the north-south alley, 20 feet wide, which is westerly of and abutting the westerly line of said lot 1 inclusive of the subdivision of Block 16, Joseph Campau Farm, Private Claim 609, as recorded in Liber 1, Page 256, Plats, Wayne County records; more properly described as:

Beginning at a point, said point being the intersection of the southerly line of Fort Street, 50 feet wide and the westerly line of Joseph Campau Avenue, 70 feet wide, thence S. 59 degrees, 51 minutes, 50 seconds W., 115.59 feet; thence N. 30 degrees, 08 minutes, 10 seconds W., 20.00 feet; thence N. 59 degrees, 51 minutes, 50 seconds E., 117.00 feet; thence S. 26 degrees, 07 minutes, 10 seconds E., 20.05 feet to the point of beginning.

For the purpose of installing, maintaining, repairing, removing or replacing any water mains, fire hydrants and appurtenances, with the right of ingress or egress at any time to, and over said easement for the purpose above set forth.

Free and easy access to the water mains, fire hydrants and appurtenances within the easement, is required for Detroit Metropolitan Water Services equipment including

the use of backhoes, bull dozers, cranes or pipe trucks and other heavy construction equipment as necessary for alteration or repair of the main and facilities.

The Detroit Metropolitan Water Services retains the right to install suitable permanent main location guide posts over its water mains at reasonable intervals and at points of deflection.

Said owners of the adjoining property for their heirs and assigns agree that no building or structure of any nature whatsoever, including fences, porches, patios, balconies, et cetera shall be built upon said easement or that no grade changes or storage of materials shall be made within said easement without prior written approval and agreement with the Detroit Metropolitan Water Services.

That if at any time in the future, the owners of any lots abutting on said vacated street shall request the removal and/or relocation of the aforementioned utilities in said easement, such owners shall pay all costs incident to such removal and/or relocation. It is further provided that if water mains, and/or appurtenances in said easement shall break or be damaged as a result of any action on the part of the property owner, or assigns, then in such event the property owner, or assigns, shall be liable for all costs incident to the repair of such broken or damaged mains and shall also be liable for all claims for damages resulting from his action; and be it further"
