Re: Petition No. 2027, Herbert Chernick. Alley Bounded by Lahser, Glendale, Dolson and Greydale. Alley Vacation.

Gentlemen — The above petition requests the vacation of a portion of the east-west public alley 16 feet wide in the block bounded by Lahser, Glendale, Dolson and Greydale. The requested vacation was recommended by the City Plan Commission with the recommendation that sufficient land be dedicated for a new alley outlet into Dolson Avenue. The petition was then referred to us for investigation and report. Our report, accompanied by the original petition is as follows:

A Warranty Deed has been received from the petitioner, deeding to the City of Detroit, land for the new alley outlet into Dolson Avenue. This deed was approved as to form and execution by the Corporation Counsel and as to description by the City Engineer, and is attached for your Honorable Body's acceptance.

The petitioner has made satisfactory arrangements with the Department of Public Works regarding the installation of drainage and the construction of a new concrete alley and alley return on the newly dedicated outlet.

All other involved City departments and privately-owned utility companies reported that they have no objection to the proposed vacation or that they have reached satisfactory agreements with the petitioner regarding their installations therein.

An appropriate resolution is attached for consideration by your Honorable Body.
