The cost of performing this work is estimated by the Michigan Department of State Highways and Transportation to be \$74,000. The participation in the cost of this propect is estimated as follows:

The City's share is in accordance with the provisions of Act 51, P.A. 1951, and is subject to adjustment after completion of the work and final auditing of the bills. Sufficient funds are available for the City's share of the cost in Appropriation 4189.
